WHEREES, upon the Petition in writing of fourteen legal voters, residing within one mile of the road hereinafter described. (the of which is prayed for in said Petition.) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said town. did, on the eighth day of July, A.D. 184, personally examine the route proposed in said petition for a road to-wit:

COMMENCING AT THE Town road that runs east and west from the County Line to the Laberre Road at a point on said Town Road where the 1/4 Sec. Line of Section 25 intersects said town road, there worth en the 1/4 Sec. Line of Sections 25 and 24 to White Bear Lake, and having, before determining to lay out said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the laying out of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the spinion that such laying out of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby; and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out the said road, we did, on the 17th day of July A.D. 1874, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent Surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Ramsey, and State of Hinnesota.

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a Read beginning at the Town Read that runs east and west from the County Line to the Laborre read, said read being known as the Section Line read, at a point on said read where the 1/4 Section Line of Section 25 intersects said Town Read, thence North on the Quarter Section Line of Sections 25 and 24 to White Bear Lake, would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

From Quarter Section Corner on South Boundary of Section 25, thence North through Section 25, Five Thousand Two Hundred and Seventy-eight feet to 1/4 Section Corner on South Boundary of Section 24, thence continue Merth Two Thousand One Hundred and Eighty-Four and a half feet, to the South share of White Bear Lake.

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that the said Read be and is hereby laid out and established according to said survey, and the plat hereuminannexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.
