SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

July 22, 1874

WHEREAS, upon the Petition in writing of fourteen legal voters, residing within one mile of the road hereinafter described, (the _____ of which is prayed for in said Petition,) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said town, did, on the eighth day of July, A.D. 1874, personally examine the route proposed in said petition for a road to-wit:

COMMENCING AT THE Town road that runs east and west from the County Line to the Laberre Road at a point on said Town Road where the 1/4 Sec. Line of Section 25 intersects said town road, thence North on the 1/4 Sec. Line of Sections 25 and 24 to White Bear Lake, and having, before determining to lay out said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the laying out of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such laying out of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby; and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out the said road, we did, on the 17th day of July A.D. 1874, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent Surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Ramsey, and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a Road beginning at the Town Road that runs east and west from the County Line to the Laberre road, said road being known as the Section Line road, at a point on said road where the 1/4 Section Line of Section 25 intersects said Town Road, thence North on the Quarter Section Line of Sections 25 and 24 to White Bear Lake, would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

From Quarter Section Corner on South Boundary of Section 25, thence North through Section 25, Five Thousand Two Hundred and Seventy-eight feet to 1/4 Section Corner on South Boundary of Section 24, thence continue North Two Thousand One Hundred and Eighty-Four and a half feet, to the South shore of White Bear Lake.

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that the said Road be and is hereby laid out and established according to said survey, and the plat herewith annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.

Road petition evidently drawn up and presented. Search did not reveal same.

We, the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear, in the County of Ramsey, having on the 22nd day of July A.D. 1874 upon due application made to us for the purpose laid out a road as follows: Commencing at the town road that runs East and West from the county line to the Labore Road, where the quarter section line of Sec. 25 intersects said road, thence North on the quarter section line of Sec. 25 and 24 to White Bear Lake, and certain owners of lands over which the road passes, to-wit:

August Preaba, Joseph Auger, Mitchell Lardiff, R. M. Staigg, Felix Labarre, Jennie D. Hoskins, R. M. Gabusha, J. E. and J. A. Fisher and others unknown, not having released all damages sustained by reason of laying out and opening the same, and not having agreed upon the amount of such damages, though we applied to them, and each of them, for that purpose, and endeavored to make such agreement, we proceeded to assess the same at what we deemed just and right to each individual claimant, taking into account, and estimating the advantage and benefits the road will confer on the claimants for the same, as well as the disadvantages, and have assessed the damages to each as follows:

To August Preaba on the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 25, \$50.00 being inclosed and partly cultivated land.

Jos. Auger on the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 25.

Mitchell Lardiff and Felix Labarre on the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ and the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$.

Jennie D. Hoskins on the $NE\frac{1}{4}$.

J. E. and J. A. Fisher on the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ all in Sec. 25, and R. M. Staigg on Lots 1 and 2 in Sec. 24 and others unknown, through which the road may pass, we estimate that the advantages and benefits, said road will confer on the above named parties are equal to all damages sustained by them by reason of laying out said road.

Commencing at the Town Road that runs east and west from the County
Line to the Labarre road, at a point on said road where the Quarter Section of
Section Twenty-five intersects said Town Road, thence North on the said
Quarter Line of Sections Twenty-five and Section Twenty-four to White Bear Lake.

The names of the owners of lands over which the same is to pass, which
are known to your petitioners, are the following:

August Preaba, Joseph Auge, Mitchell Tardiff, and others unknown.

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to lay out said road,
and cause the same to be opened according to law.
