WHEREAS, upon the Petition in writing of Philando Long, John E. Extrend, Franklin Clevet, Elijah Long, Albert Clevet Stavet Thos. Hilner, D. C. Refresh, L. H. Bacon, six legal voters, residing within one mile of the route hereinafter described, (the of which is prayed for in said Petition,) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said town, did, on the 25th day of Angust, A.D. 1875, personally examine the route proposed in said patition for a new road to-wit;

Commencing at the Town Road known as the Stillwater and Contreville Road at a point on said road, where said road crosses the L. S. and M. R.R. an en the West side thereof, or as near said crossing as practicable, thence South along said R.R. to 8th St. in the town of White Bear, thence East along 8th St. to Cooks Avenue, thence South along Cooks Avenue to 4th St. thence West along 4th Street to the Depot, and having, before determining to lay out said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reason for or against the laying out of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said read tea days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were effered, and being of the opinion that such laying out of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out the said read, we did, on the 4th day of September A.D. 1875, caused a survey thereof to be made by a competent Surveyor who made report to us, as fellows, to-with

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Remsey, and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a Read beginning at the Town Road known as the Stillwater and Centreville Road at a point on said road where said road crosses the L.S. & M. R.R. and on the West side thereof or as near said Railroad as practicable on the west side thereof, to 8th Street in the Town of White Bear, thence east along 8th to Cecke Ave., thence South along Cook Ave. to 4th Street, thence West along 4th St. to the Depot. would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the Stillwater and Centreville road, 637 feet west of where said road crosses the L.S. & H. R.R. running thence S.3 E. 450 ft. thence S. 11° W. 200 ft., thence S. 22° E. 228 ft., thence East 300 ft., to a point 50 ft. West of the center of the L.S. M. R.R., thence Southerly along said R.R. and parallel thereto 830 feet to H. side of 8th Street in the Town of White Bear, thence E. along said 8th Street to Gooke Avenue, thence S. along Cooke Avenue to 4th St., thence W. along 4th Street to the Railroad Avenue.

It is therefore, ordered and determined that the said Road be and is hereby laid out and established according to said survey, and the plat hereunts annexed and made part of this orders which road is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.
