

SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

For Altering a Road.

WHEREAS, upon the Petition in writing of J. H. DeJarvis, Henry Compselle, L. O. Peltier, A. J. Peltier, Thomas Garsom, Louis Ducharme, A. Robson, seven legal voters, residing within one mile of the Road hereinafter described, (the altering of which is prayed for in said Petition,) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said town, did, on the 25th day of November, A.D. 1895, personally examine the route of the road proposed in said petition to be altered, to-wit:

To vacate that part of a Road which is known as the Oilfield Road and commencing at Mississippi Street Extension and running west until Edgerton Street from Edgerton Street to Vadnais Lake that part of said Road to be kept open and vacate that part of said road running along the North-east Shore of said Vadnais Lake until up to the quarter section line of Section (32) Thirty-two, Town (30) Thirty, Range (23), Twenty-two, and lay out a new Road running on said quarter section line of Section (32) Thirty-two, Town (30) Thirty, Range (23) Twenty-two East to Edgerton Street, distance about four hundred feet.

and having, before determining to alter said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the altering of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such altering of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to alter the said road, we did, on the 25th day of November A.D. 1895, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of \_\_\_\_\_ in the County of \_\_\_\_\_ and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a Road beginning at \_\_\_\_\_

would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that the said Road be and is hereby altered and established according to said survey, and the plat herewith annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Ramsey and  
 State of Minnesota:

The undersigned, legal voters, residing within one mile of the route hereinafter mentioned and described for altering road, do hereby petition to you to lay out a new road of the width of four rods, as follows:

To vacate that part of a Road which is known as the Gillfillan Road and commencing at Mississippi Street Extension and running West until Edgerton Street from Edgerton Street to Vadnais Lake. That part of said Road to be kept open and vacate that part of said Road running along the Northeast Shore of said Vadnais Lake until up to the quarter section line of Section (32) Thirty-two, Town (30) Thirty, Range (22) Twenty-two and lay out a new Road running on said quarter section line of Section (32) Thirty-two, Town (30) Thirty, Range (22) Twenty-two east to Edgerton Street distance about four hundred feet.

The names of the owners of lands over which the same is to pass, which are known to your petitioners, are the following:

David Gersman Part of N.E. 1/4 Section 32, Town 30, Range 22

G.M. Harmon (et al) Lot 1 or 2, Section 32, Town 30, Range 22

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to lay out said road, and cause the same to be opened according to law.
