

SUPERVISORS' ORDER

Vacating Two Roads

Aug. 30, 1897

WHEREAS, upon the Petition in writing of Paul Capistrant, Ole Benson, John Hanson, M. Dillon, S. Troedson, C. D. Feltner, C. Pannison, Eels Nelson, Geo. H. Freeman, mine legal voters, residing within one mile of the Roads hereinafter described, (the vacating of which is prayed for in said petition,) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said town, did, on the 30th day of August A.D. 1897, personally examine the two roads proposed in said petition to be vacated, to-wit:

Beginning at the Section Corner of Sections 15 and 16, 9 and 20, Town 30, Range 23, running South along the Section line between Sections 15 and 16 about 400 feet (more or less) thence southeasterly through the N.W. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4 of Section 15 to the forty-acre line between Lots 1 and 2 and the North 1/2 of N.W. 1/4 of Section 15, thence East on the above mentioned 40-acre line to the 1/4 Section line running North and South through the center of Section 15. And the other road runs about 400 feet on Section line between Sections 15 and 16 and then runs in an easterly direction to the intersection of Otter Lake road in Section 15 according to map.

and having, before determining to vacate said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to bring any reasons for or against the vacating of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such vacating of said roads is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to vacate the said roads, we did, on the 30th day of August A.D. 1897, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent Surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of _____ in the County of _____ and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a Road beginning at _____

would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that the said Roads be and are hereby vacated according to said survey, and the plat herewith annexed and made part of this order, which roads are hereby declared to be a public highway no longer.

For Vacating Two Roads.

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear, in the County of
Ramsey and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned, legal voters, residing within one mile of the roads
hereinafter mentioned and described to be vacated, do hereby petition to you
to vacate two roads as follows:

Beginning at the Section Corner of Sections 15 and 16, 9 and 10, Town
30, Range 22 running South along the Section line between Sections 15 and 16,
about 400 feet (more or less) thence Southeasterly through the N.W. 1/4 of N.W.
1/4 of Section 15 to the forty acre line between Lots 1 and 2 and the North 1/2
of N.W. 1/4 of Section 15, thence East on the above mentioned forty-acre line
to the 1/4 Section Line running North and South through the Centre of Section
15 and the other road runs about 400 feet on Section line between Section 15
and 16 and then runs in an Easterly direction to the intersection of Otter Lake
road in Section 15 according to map.

The names of the owners of lands over which the same now pass which
are known to your petitioners, are the following:

- John Hammon N.W. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4 of Section 15
- Mrs. Wm. Freeman S 1/2 of N.W. 1/4 of Section 15

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to vacate said roads and cause
the same to be vacated according to law.
