SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

April 10, 1900

Changing Road.

WHEREAS, upon the Petition in writing of N. E. McInnes, Jacob Molitor, Stephen S. Hall, Paul Cupistrant, John Delonais, Alfred Gustaf, Peter Bibean, Gust Lundgren, Henry Lee, and John Asplund, ten legal voters, residing within one mile of the Road, hereinafter described, (the altering of which is prayed for in said Petition,) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said Town, did, on the 10th day of April A. D. 1900, personally examine the road proposed in said petition to be altered, to-wit:

To vacate so much of a certain Town Road as runs diagonally through the Southeast Quarter, S.E. 1/4, of the Northwest Quarter, N.W. 1/4, of Section Six, 6, Town Thirty, 30, Range Twenty-two, 22, and lay out a new road as follows: Commencing at the Southeast Corner of the Southeast Quarter, S.E. 1/4, of the Northwest Quarter, N.W. 1/4, of Section Six, 6, Town Thirty, 30, Range Twenty-two, 22, thence East on Quarter Section Line to the center of said Section Six, 6, thence North on the Quarter Section Line to the intersection of the present Town Road.

and having, before determining to alter said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the altering of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such altering of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to alter the said road, we did, on the 10th day of April A. D. 1900, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of _____ in the County of _____ and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a Road beginning at _____

would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that the said Road be and is hereby laid out and established according to said survey, and the plat hereunto annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.

For Altering Road.

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the
County of Ramsey and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned, legal voters, residing within one mile of the route
hereinafter mentioned and described for a road, do hereby petition to you to
lay out a new road, of the width of four rods, as follows:

To vacate so much of a certain road as runs diagonally through the
Southeast Quarter, S.E. 1/4, of the Northwest Quarter, N.W. 1/4, of Section
Six, 6, Town Thirty, 30, Range Twenty-two, 22. And lay out a new road as
follows: Commencing at the Southwest Corner of the Southeast Quarter, S.E. 1/4,
of the Northwest Quarter, N.W. 1/4, of Section Six, 6, Town Thirty, 30, Range
Twenty-two, 22; thence East on Quarter Section Line to the center of said
Section Six, 6, thence North on the Quarter Section Line to the intersection
of the present Town Road.

The names of the owners of lands over which the same is to pass,
which are known to your petitioners, are the following:

John Asplund	S.E. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4, Section 6, Town 30, Range 22

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to lay out said
road, and cause the same to be opened according to law.
