Altering a Road

Nov. 18, 1901

WHEREAS, upon the Petition in writing of David G. Young, F. W. Benson, G. D. Peltier, R. H. Lang, Edward Lang, James Melitar, G. Fournelle, Nic Fournelle, Mrs. E. J. Cobb, eight legal voters, residing within two miles of the road hereinafter described (the altering of which is prayed for in said Petition), a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said town, did, on the 18th day of November A.D. 1901, personally examine the road proposed in said petition to be altered, to-wit:

To vacate that part of a road that runs diagonally through the Southeast Quarter, S.E. 1/4, of the Southeast Quarter, S.E. 1/4, of Section Eleven, 11, Town Thirty, 30, Range Twenty-two, 22, and in place of said vacated road to open a road on the South line of said Southeast Quarter, S.E. 1/4, of the Southeast Quarter, S.E. 1/4, of Section Eleven, 11, Town Thirty, 30, Range Twenty-two, 22, and extending from Division One East to the Right of Way of S.P. & D. R.R.

and having, before determining to alter said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the altering of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such altering of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to alter the said road, we did, on the 18th day of November A.D. 1901, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of _____ in the County of _____ and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a road beginning at _____

would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that the said Road be and is hereby altered and established according to said survey, and the plat herewith annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the
County of Ramsey, and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned, legal voters, residing within one mile of the
route hereinafter mentioned and described for a road, do hereby petition to
you to alter a road, of the width of four rods, as follows:

To vacate that part of a road that runs diagonally through the
Southeast quarter, S.E. 1/4, of the Southeast quarter, S.E. 1/4, of Sec-
tion Eleven, 11, Town Thirty, 30, Range Twenty-two, 22. And in place of
vacated road to open a road on the South line of the Southeast quarter,
S.E. 1/4, of the Southeast Quarter, S.E. 1/4, of Section Eleven, 11, Town
Thirty, 30, Range Twenty-two, 22, and extending from Division One East to
the right-of-way of St. Paul and Duluth. R.R.

The names of the owners of lands over which the same is to pass,
which are known to your petitioners, are the following:

Ella J. Cobb, S.E. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4 of Section 11, Town 30, Range 22.

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to alter said
road, and cause the same to be opened according to law.
