SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER  
For Laying out Cartway

June 2, 1902

WHEREAS, upon the Petition in writing of Garcise Belland, Paul Capistrant, G. D. Peltier, Wm. Bassel, Peter Zimmer, H. Wiegand, Peter Becker, John Kieffer, Isidor Kieffer, Nic. Kieffer, Chas. Rebeck, Emory Vincent, Jentry Rapp, George S. Belland, fourteen legal voters, residing within three miles of the cartway hereinafter described, (the laying out of which is prayed for in said Petition,) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors, of said town, did, on the Second day of June A.D. 1902, personally examine the route proposed in said Petition for a Cartway, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on a certain road called Birch Lake road where the Quarter Section line of Section Twenty-one, T1, Town 30, Thirty, Range 23, Twenty-two, intersects said road, thence running East on said quarter Section line of said Section 21, Twenty-one, to the corner Stone between Sections 21, Twenty-one, and 22, Twenty-two, Town 30, Thirty, Range 23, Twenty-two, thence East on quarter Section line of said Section Twenty-two to a mark called Rice Lake.

and having, before determining to lay out said Cartway, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the laying out of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said Cartway ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such laying out of the said Cartway is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out the said Cartway, we did, on the 2nd day of June A.D. 1902, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent Surveyor, who made report to us as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Ramsey and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a Road beginning at \_\_\_\_\_

would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that the said Cartway be and is hereby laid out and established according to said survey, and the plat hereunto annexed and made part of this order, which Cartway is hereby declared to be a public highway two rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Ramsey,  
 and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned, legal voters, residing within three miles of the route hereinafter mentioned and described for a Cartway hereby petition to you to lay out a Cartway of the width of two rods, as follows:

Beginning at a point on a certain road called Birch Lake road where the quarter Section line of Section 21, Twenty-one, Town 30, Thirty, Range 22, Twenty-two, intersects said road, thence running East on Quarter Section line of said Section 21, Twenty-one, to the Corner Stone between Sections 21, Twenty-one, and 22 Twenty-two, Town 30, Thirty, Range 22, Twenty-two, thence East on Quarter Section line of said Section 22, Twenty-two, to a marsh called Rice Lake.
