SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

WHEREAS, upon the petition in writing of E. H. Erickson, Alfred Gustafson, Peter Olson, A. F. Asplund, Andrew P. Hanson, Louis Wainio, Thomas Dufresne, Joseph Parisson, Gust Lundgren, Jacob Malter, R. V. Narvin, G. K. Eastman, Alfred Charest, Carl N. Morrill, W. E. McKissick, Supt., John Stromberg, sixteen legal voters, residing within three miles of the road hereinafter described, (the laying out of which is prayed for in said Petition,) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said towns did, on the 17th day of May A.D. 1905, personally examine the road proposed in said petition to be laid out, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the N.W. 1/4, Northwest quarter, of N.E. 1/4, Northeast quarter, of Section 6, six, Town 30, Thirty, Range 23, Twenty-two, thence running West on the North line of said Section 6, six, to the Northeast corner of the N.E. 1/4, Northeast quarter, of N.W. 1/4, Northwest quarter, of Section 6, Six, Town 30, Thirty, Range 22, Twenty-two, and there terminating, and having, before determining to lay out said road, fixed upon a time and place where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the laying out of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such laying out of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out the said road, we did, on the 17th day of May A.D. 1905, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of _____ in the County of _____ and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a Road beginning at _____

would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that the said Road be and is hereby laid out and established according to said survey, and the plat herewith annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear, in the County of Ramsey,
 and the Supervisors of the Town of Centreville in the County of Anoka, and State
 of Minnesota:

The undersigned, legal voters, residing within three miles of the
 route hereinafter mentioned and described for a road, do hereby petition to you
 to lay out a new road, of the width of four rods, as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section
 6, Six, Town 30, Range 22. Thence running West on the North line of said Sec-
 tion 6 to the Northeast corner of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, Town 30, Range
 22, and there terminating.

The names of the owners of lands over which the same is to pass, which
 are known to your petitioners, are the following:
