WHEREAS, upon the Petition in writing of Carl M. Morrell, M. R. McKissick, Supt., John Stromberg, Oliver Leney, Alfred Chareet, R. V. Marvin, G. K. Eastman, Andrew Amberson, Jacob Molitor, Gast Landgren, ten legal voters, residing within three miles of the road hereinafter described, (the altering of which is prayed for in said Petition.) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said town, did, on the 17th day of May A.D. 1905, persenally examine the road proposed in said petition to be altered, to-wit:
