To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Ramsey,

The undersigned, legal voters, residing within three miles of the route  
 hereinafter mentioned and described for a road, do hereby petition to you to  
 alter a road, of the width of four rods, as follows:

To vacate that part of a certain road which runs diagonally through  
 the N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 6, Township 30, Range 22. And in place of said  
 vacated road to lay out a new road as follows: Beginning at the Northwest  
 corner of the N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  and the Northeast corner of the N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$   
 of Section 6, Town 30, Range 22. thence running South to the intersection of  
 the present road.

The names of the owners of lands over which the same is to pass, which  
 are known to your petitioners, are the following:

Altering road

WHEREAS, upon the Petition in writing of Carl N. Merrell, N. E. McKissick, Supt., John Stromberg, Oliver Lemay, Alfred Charest, R. V. Marvin, G. K. Eastman, Andrew Anderson, Jacob Molitor, Gust Lundgren, ten legal voters, residing within three miles of the road hereinafter described, (the altering of which is prayed for in said Petition,) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said town, did, on the 17th day of May A.D. 1905, personally examine the road proposed in said petition to be altered, to-wit:

To vacate that part of a certain road which runs diagonally through the N.W. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4 of Section 6, Town 30, Range 22. And in place of said vacated road to lay out a new road as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of the N.W. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4 and the Northeast corner of the N.E. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4 Section 6, Town 30, Range 22, thence running South to the intersection of the present road, and having, before determining to alter said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the altering of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such altering of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to alter the said road, we did on the 17th day of May A.D. 1905, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of \_\_\_\_\_ in the County of \_\_\_\_\_ and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a Road, beginning at \_\_\_\_\_

would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that the said Road be and is hereby altered and established according to said survey, and the plat herewith annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.
