SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

Nov. 20, 1909

Vacating and Altering Road.

WHEREAS, upon the Petition in writing of Carl Streh, Geo. S. Belland, M. Vincent, Carl Majalla, Augustus Garsom, Alex. Bihm, Chas. Marandt, Christian Majalla, A. J. Zeltier, P. Valente, Bedros Morrisette, Thomas Garsom, Emil Anderson, N. Hubertis, F. Dubois, Henry Rapp, Peter Zimmer, H. P. Kohn, Emil Boesel, Chas. J. Kohler and Edward Kohler, twenty-one legal voters, residing within three miles of the road hereinafter described (the vacating and altering of which is prayed for in said Petition,) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we the Supervisors of said town, did, on the 20th day of November, A.D. 1909, personally examine the road proposed in said petition to be vacated and altered, to-wit:

Beginning at the  $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. corner between Sections 19 and 20, T. 30, R. 22, and running thence Northwesterly, Northerly and Northwesterly to a point on the E. line of the N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 19, so that the same when changed will run as follows: Beginning at the  $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. corner between Sections 19 and 20, T. 30, R. 22, and running thence North on the Sec. line between said Sections 19 and 20 to the E.E. corner of said Sec. 19, to be four (4) rods in width, and to be connected with Lake Johanna and White Bear road on the North.

and, having, before determining to vacate and alter said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the vacating and altering of the same, and having caused written notice thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such vacating and altering of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to vacate and alter the said road, we did, on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ A.D. 1909 cause a survey thereof to be made by competent Surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions to-wit:

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that the said Road be and is hereby laid out and established according to said survey, and the plan hereto annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said road.

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Ramsey  
and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned, legal voters, residing within three miles of the route  
hereinafter mentioned and described for a road, do hereby petition to you to lay  
out a new road, of the width of four rods, as follows. Commencing at the S.E.  
corner of Sec. 19, T. 30, R. 22, thence running N. 1/2 mile to the  $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. corner  
thence running Northeasterly, Northerly and Northwesterly to a point on the E.  
line of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 19, and your petitioners pray that you will  
change all that portion of said above described highway which runs as follows:

Beginning at the  $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. corner between Sections 19 and 20, of T. 30,  
R. 22, and running thence Northwesterly, Northerly and Northwesterly to a point  
on the N. line of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 19 and now connected with Lake Johanna  
and White Bear Road on the North so that the same when changed will run as fol-  
lows: Beginning at the  $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. corner between Sections 19 and 20, T. 30, R. 22,  
and running thence N. on the Section line between said Sections 19 and 20 to the  
E.E. corner of said Sec. 19, and to be four (4) rods in width, and to be con-  
nected with Lake Johanna and White Bear Road on the North.

The names of the owners of lands over which the same is to pass, which  
are known to your petitioners, are the following:

Edward Kohler	East $\frac{1}{2}$ of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 19, T. 30, R. 22
Carl Streh	Northwest $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 20, T. 30, R. 22, except part taken by Minneapolis, St. Paul and Sault Ste Marie Railway Company for right-of-way.

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to lay out said road,  
and cause the same to be opened according to law.
