Laying out a Cartway.

WHEREAS, upon the Petition in writing of A. M. Lawton,
G. J. Backus, N. W. Trust Co. as Receivers for Citizens' Savings Bank, by
Ira C. Oshier, Sec'y., Edw. Gill, Louis Haar, John D. Neff, Geo. L. Spangler,
Samuel Beard, T. L. Mann, C. B. Lawton; per A. M. Lawton, Charles L. Covell,
Angelica Lawton, Percy D. Godfrey, John N. Thayer, N. P. Engstrom, Geo. Lamette,
Andrew Felix, Joseph Taylor, Joe Labore, Wm. Flynn, W. H. Cummings, John V.
Wheeler, F. J. Heckel and Fred Heckel, Sr., twenty-four legal voters, resid-
ing within three miles of the cartway hereinafter described, (the laying out
of which is prayed for in said Petition,) a copy of their petition having been
first duly posted; as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said towns, do
on the 16th day of May A.D. 1910, personally examine the cartway proposed in
said petition, to-wit:

Beginning at the South line of the right-of-way of the Minneapolis,
St. Paul and Sault St. Marie Railway; running thence southwesterly along the boundary
line between Washington and Ramsey Counties to Lake Avenue on the northwesterly line
of the Northern Pacific Railway, and that the width of said cartway be two (2)
rods, measuring one (1) rod on either (each) side of the aforesaid boundary be-
tween said Counties.

and having, before determining to lay out said Cartway, fixed upon a time and
place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the laying
out of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in
three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of
such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such
reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that
such laying out of the said Cartway is necessary and proper, and that the public
interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said peti-
tioners, and determined to lay out the said road, we did, on the _____ of
A.D. 18_____, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent Surveyor,
who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear, Ramsey County, and Grant in the County of Washington, and State of Minnesota

The undersigned, legal voters, residing within three miles of the route hereinafter mentioned and described for a road, do hereby petition to you to lay out a Cartway of the width of two rods, as follows: Commencing at the South line of the right-of-way of the Minneapolis, St. Paul and Sault St. Marie Railway; running thence southerly along the boundary line between Washington and Ramsey Counties to Lake Avenue on the northerly line of the Northern Pacific Railway, and that the width of said cartway be two (2) rods measuring one(1) rod on either side of the aforesaid boundary between said Counties.

The names of the owners of lands over which the same is to pass, which are known to your petitioners, are the following:

Lena Wagner part lying south of Minneapolis, St. Paul and Sault St. Marie R.R. East of Portland Ave. and north of First St., except part owned by John A. Barker and Angelica Lawton, Sec. 12, T. 30, R. 22.

John A. Barker, part lying south of Minneapolis, St. Paul and Sault St. Marie R.R. east of Portland Ave. and north of First St., except part owned by Lena Wagner and Angelica Lawton, Sec. 12, T. 30, R. 22.

H. E. Wheeler, North 363.59 ft. of Lot 1, Block 2, Bellwood, according to plat on file with Register of Deeds of Washington Co., Minn.
