WHEREAS, upon the Petition in writing of Hals Anderson, G. E. Smith, J. E. Johnson, A. E. Hooker, A. P. Thompson, H. A. Warner, Peter Journelle, Joseph Reif, L. Bures, and Harry Freeman, ten legal voters, residing within three miles of the Cartway hereinafter described, (the vacating of which is prayed for in said Petition,) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors, of said town, did, on the 28th day of May A.D. 1910, personally examine the cartway proposed in said petition to be vacated, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the County Road running alongside R.R. about one thousand (1000) ft. North of the S.W. corner of the S.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. one (1), Township 30, Range 23, thence running West parallel through lot three (3), Sec. Two, (2), Township 30, Range 23, to said Eagle Lake,

and, having before determining to vacate said cartway, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the vacating of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such vacating of the said Cartway is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to vacate the said cartway, we did, on the _____ A.D. 19____, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent Surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of _____ in the County of _____ and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a Road beginning at _____

would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that the said Road be and is hereby vacated according to said survey, and the plat hereunto annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be vacated, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.
