WHEREAS, upon the Petition, in writing of Edward Thomson, Wm. Ferron, Eugene Arcand, J. E. Kjansson, F. W. Horton, E. Edwin, J. E. Hamr, G. S. Clayson, Fred. Arcand, Chas. Erickson, R. R. Stephens, S. A. Anderson, A. L. Crawford, M. V. Webb, J. H. Ritchie, Warner R. Schmitz, Jas. Riddie, R. J. Bloom, L. J. Robertson and Anton Bloom, twenty (20) legal voters residing within three (3) miles of the road hereinafter described, (the opening of which is prayed for in said Petition,) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said Town, did, on the 26th day of August A.D. 1922, personally examine the road to be laid out as proposed in said petition, to-wit:

Beginning at Northwest Avenue, running thence N. to Portland Avenue about six blocks and being a part of Buffalo and Warren Avenues, said road to be four rods in width, two rods on either side of the centre line of said road, and said road to be known as Warren Avenue,

and having, before determining to lay out said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the laying out of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such laying out of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out the said road, we did, on the ___ day of _____ A. D. 19__ cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of _____ in the County of _____ and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a Road beginning at _____

and would report that the following is a correct survey thereof, as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that the said Road be and is hereby laid out and established according to said survey, and the plat herewith annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Ramsey,
 and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned, legal voters, residing within three miles of the route hereinafter mentioned and described for a road, do hereby petition to you to lay out a new road, of the width of four rods, as follows: Commencing at the Northwest Ave. running thence E. to Portland Ave. about six blocks and being a part of Buffalo Ave. and Warren Ave.; said road to be four rods in width, two rods on either side of the center line of said road; said road to be known as Warren Ave.
