WHEREAS, upon the Petition in writing of eight legal voters, to-wit: Victor Hisswandt, R. A. Ball, William Molitor, Andrew Anderson, Charles A. Anderson, L. Bures, Louis Molitor and August Molitor, (8) legal voters, residing within one mile of the road hereinafter described, (the vacating of which is prayed for in said Petition,) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors, of said town, did, on the 27th day of October A.D. 1923, personally examine the road proposed in said petition to be vacated, to-wit:

Beginning at the center line of the Centreville road and running in an easterly direction to the center line of the Otter Lake road; the whole of said Town Road lying on the N. 1/2 of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. four (4), Town thirty (30) Range twenty-two (22), and Government Lot No. One (1), in the N. 1/2 of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. three (3), Town thirty (30), Range twenty-two (22).

and having, before determining to vacate said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet and hear any reasons for or against the vacation of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such vacation of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to vacate the said road, we did, on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ A.D. 19\_\_\_\_ cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

for Vacation of Road.

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Ranney,  
and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned, legal voters, residing within three miles of the route hereinafter mentioned and described do hereby petition to you to vacate a road, of the width of four rods, as follows: Commencing at the center line of the Centreville road and running in an easterly direction to the center line of the Otter Lake road; the whole of said road lying in the N.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. four (4), Town thirty (30), Range twenty-two (22), and Government Lot No. One (1) in the N.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. three (3), Town thirty (30), Range twenty-two (22).

The names of the owners of lands over which the same is to pass, which are known to your petitioners, are the following:
