Vacating part

Sept. 20, 1924

WHEREAS, upon the Petition in writing of eleven (11) legal voters, to-wit: Eugene L. Arund, Fred Arund, Oliver Blackbird, Euclid Polopin, Harvey M. Gordon, Robert O'Leary, J. E. Ham, L. E. Johnson, Phil L. Manner, Adolph Donaldson and John Bower, 11 legal voters, residing within one side of the road hereinafter described, (the vacation of which is prayed for in said Petition,) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said town, did, on the 20th day of September, A.D. 1924, personally examine the road proposed in said petition to be vacated, to-wit: That part of Franklin Avenue which extends over and across the N.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 12, T. 20, R. 22, from Sixth Street to the N. line of Sec. 12, which part of Franklin Avenue is situated in Rice's Addition to White Bear according to plat recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Ramsey Co. Minnesota, and having, before determining to vacate said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the vacation of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such vacation of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to vacate the said road, we did, on the _____ day of _____ A.D. 19____ cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent Surveyor who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of _____ in the County of _____ and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a Road beginning at _____

would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your directions, to-wit:

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that the said Road be and is hereby laid out and established according to said survey, and the plat herewith annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public Highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of _____ and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned, legal voters, residing within three miles of the route hereinafter mentioned and described to be vacated, do hereby petition to you to vacate a road, of the width of four rods, as follows:

That part of Franklin Avenue which extends over and across the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12, T. 30, R. 22; from Sixth Street to the N. line of Sec. 12, which part of Franklin Avenue is situated in Rice's Addition to White Bear according to plat recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Ramsey Co., Minn.

The names of the owners of lands over which the same is to pass, which are known to your petitioners, are the following:
