

SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

Nov. 22, 1924

Vacating road.

WHEREAS, upon the Petition, in writing, of Ed. Vincent, Joe. E. Howard, Charles Maranda, Frank Bibson, Raphael Bibson, Anthony Bibson, Edward E. Belland, Albert J. Peltier, R. J. Belland, and Edgar H. Belland, ten legal voters, residing within one mile of the road hereinafter described, (the vacation of which is prayed for in said Petition,) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said town, did, on the 22nd day of November, A.D. 1924, personally examine the road proposed to be vacated in said petition, to-wit:

Beginning at the N.E. corner of Lot #3, Sec. 22, T. 30, R. 22, thence running westerly and Northwesterly along the shore of Vadmis Lake to the E. line of Sec. 22, and thence N. along the W. line of said Sec. 22, and the E. line of Sec. 29, T. 30, R. 22, to a road traversing in an easterly direction from the N.E. corner of the S.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 29, T. 30 R. 22, along the E. line of the S 1/2 of the S.W. 1/4 of said Sec. 29.

and having, before determining to vacate said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the vacation of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such vacation of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to vacate the said road, we did, on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ A.D. 1924 cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor, who made report to us as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear, in the County of Ramsey,

Sec. 29, T. 30, R. 22 to a road traversing in an easterly direction from the N.W.  
corner of the S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 29, T. 30, R. 22, along the N. line of  
the S  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 29.
