whereas, upon the petition of six legal voters owning real estate within one mile of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said Town and Village at least twenty days before any action was had in relation therete; proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit: which said proposed new road is set forth and described in said petition as follows: vis, Beginning at a point on Park Avenue So-called in the platted Town of Bald Eagle where said Park Avenue intersects Eagle Street, thence west on said Park Avenue to White Bear Street; thence South on said White Bear Street to the North line of the SE t of Section 11. Thence West to the HE corner of the said SE t of the SE t of Section 11. Town 30, Range 22, Thence South along the forty acre lime between the SE t of the SE t and the NF t of the SE t of said Section 11 and the HE t of the HE t and the HE t of Section 14, Town 30, Range 22; to Division Street in the Village of White Bear.

AND WHEREAS, Upon receiving said petition we did within thirty: days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application to-wit: On the 23rd day of August, 1886, at three o'clock in the afternoon at the house of Fred Maximer in said Village, causing copies of such Motice to be posted in three public places of said Town and Village at least ten days previous to such meeting, and having met at such time and place as above named in said Motice, and being satisfied that the applicant had at least ten days previous to said time saused such Motice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the companie of the land through which such highway might pass by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of such occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we preceded to examine personally such highway and heard any and all reasons for or against laying out the same, and being of the opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper and that the public interests would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road.

It is therefore ordered and determined that a road be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description aforesaid, and it is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said road,
