

Beginning at a point where the present traveled road intersects the northerly and southerly $\frac{1}{4}$ section line of section 16, township 30, range 22, and running thence northeasterly through sections 16 and 9, said Town and Range, to a point where said section 9, township 30, range 22, so that the same when so changed will run as follows:

Beginning at a point where the present traveled road intersects the northerly and southerly $\frac{1}{4}$ section line of section 16, township 30, range 22, and running thence northerly on the $\frac{1}{4}$ section line through sections 16 and 9, said Town and Range, to the center of said section 9; thence east on the $\frac{1}{4}$ section line to the intersection of the present traveled road, and we do recommend that prayer of petition be granted, except that the old road be not vacated, until the new road is completed and ready for travel.
