

SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

WHEREAS, Upon the petition of six legal voters residing within one mile of the road to be laid out, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said town at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, which said proposed new road is set forth and described in said petition as follows; Commencing at Clark Avenue in the town of White Bear, at a point on said Clark Avenue where Third Street in said Town of White Bear intersects said Avenue and on the east side thereof thence East along said Third Street to Stewart Avenue, thence South along Stewart Avenue to White Bear Lake.

AND WHEREAS, Upon receiving said petition we did within thirty days make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application to-wit: on the 20th day of June A.D. 1876 at the store of W. S. Chase in said Town at 10 o'clock in the forenoon, causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said town at least ten days previous to such meeting, and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, we proceeded to examine personally such highway and heard any and all reasons for or against laying out the same, and being of the opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper, and that the public interests would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of the petitioner and determined to lay out said road.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DETERMINED that a road be and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description aforesaid and it is hereby declared to be a public highway 60 feet wide, the centre of said streets being the centre of said road.
