To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of the County of Ramsey, Minnesota -

The undersigned free-holders of the county of Ramsey residing therein petition your honorable Board for the change of a highway, running into more than one town of said county, and within the limits of any incorporated City, and known as the St. Paul and Stillwater ROAD, and described as follows:

Beginning at the Potter Road, so-called, where the same now intersects the St. Paul and Stillwater Road,

And running thence Northeasterly and easterly as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the Potter and Stillwater Roads, thence South 76 degrees 12' E. 184 feet, thence N. 81 degrees 48' E. 435 feet, thence N. 68 degrees 48' E. 195 feet, thence N. 56 degrees 48' E. 473 feet, and thence continuing in a general Northeasterly course through Ramsey County, to the line between said Ramsey County and Washington County, thence continuing generally in said direction to the City of Stillwater in said County of Washington.

And your petitioners pray that you will change all that portion of said above described highway which runs as follows, in said County of Ramsey:

Beginning at the Potter Road so-called, and running thence Northeasterly and easterly as near as practicable as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the Potter and Stillwater Roads, thence S. 76 degrees 12' E. 184 feet, thence N. 81 degrees 48' E. 435 feet, thence N. 68 degrees 48' E. 195 feet, thence N. 56 degrees 48' E. 473 feet, and terminating at a point about 1287 feet Northeasterly of the Potter Road, being the place of beginning, and now connected with the Potter Road.

So that the same when changed will run as follows:

Beginning at Minnehaha Street where the same intersects the Potter Road so-called, and running thence Northeasterly and Northerly as near as practicable as follows:

Commencing at the S.W. corner of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 25, Township 29, Range 22, thence N. 50 degrees 28' E. 481 feet, thence N. 33 degrees 14' E. 1595 feet, thence N. 4 degrees 46' W. 701 feet, to the center of the Stillwater Road about 1287 feet easterly of the center of the Potter Road, and terminating at the Stillwater Road, and to be four rods in width.

And to be connected with other roads as follows: Minnehaha Street, Potter Road and Stillwater Road.

The names of the owners of the lands, as far as known, through which the same now passes, are: Bernard McGuire,

And the names of the owners of the lands, as far as known through which the same may pass when changed, are Bernard McGuire, Noyes Bros. & Cutler, Elsie M. Shawe, Theodore L. Schurmeier, and your petitioners pray that you will proceed to change said road, and cause the same to be opened according to law.
