

977.95; thence S.2024.85 to the center of Section three (3). And recommended
that the prayer of the petitioners for the location of said highway be greated
and a majority of the Board of County Commissioners being of the spinion that
the public interest would be premoted by the lucating of said highway, and that
the locating of said road would be of sufficient advantage to the county to
warrant the payment of the damages hereinafter assessed, we do hereby order and
determine that the prayer of said petitioners be granted, and that a highway be
and is hereby located, according to the description above given, which is hereby declared to be a public highway; and the Anditor is hereby directed to settly
the supervisors of the several towns through which such highway is located that
they cause so much of said highway as lies in their respective towns to be epomed
without delay. We have assessed the damages sustained by reason of the location
