That Gen. R. W. Johnson, H. J. Brainard and Henry Brandt of the County of Ramsey are hereby appointed Commissioners to locate and maxvey a road sixty (60) feet wide from a point on the St. Punl and Lake
Phalen and White Bear Lake road where it crosses the Borth line of Section number twenty-seven (27) Township number twenty-nine (29) Ramge
twenty-two (22) Thence running in a Borthwest direction to the shore
of Lake Phalen and to locate and survey a road or avenue one hundred
(100) feet wide commencing where said road strikes said Lake thence
entirely around said lake and as near the shore thereof as practicable
to place of beginning.

### SECTION TWO

Said Commissioners or a majority of them shall meet at the Anditor's office in the City of St. Paul on or before the first (lst) day of June eighteen hundred and seventy-eight (1878) and there make onth that they will faithfully discharge their duties as provided by this set and impartially assess damages if any they find to be sustained by the concrete of land through which said road may run which outh shall be filed in said Auditor's office and proceed to the discharge of their duties.

## SECTION THREE

The said Commissioners are hereby authorized to employ the County Surveyor with such assistants as they may deem proper, as may be mesessary for the proper location and establishment of said read,

## SECTION FOUR

Said Commissioners shall on or before the first day of July, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight (1878) cause an accurate plat of the survey and location of said road to be made and filed in the office of the County Auditor of Ramsey County which plat shall be prima facia evidence in all courts of this state of the location survey and establishment of said road.

# SECTION FIVE

It shall be the duty of said Commissioners to appraise the damages that may accrue to the owners of any lands through which said road may be established and on or before the first day of July ment to file such appraisal in the office of County Auditor of Ramsey County.

### SECTION SIL

Any owners of lands through which said road passes may appeal from the appraisment of damages made by said Commissioners to the District Court of Ramsey County at any time within twenty (20) days after the first day of July aforesaid.

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### SECTION SEVEN

Such appeal shall be taken by the services of a notice in writing one upon County Auditor and one upon the County Ettorney of Earney County and on the filing in the office of the Clark of the District Court a copy of such notice with proof of service with a County taken and the amount of the Countsciences are together with appellants grounds of appeal the appeal will be decided to be complete and thereafter proceedings shall be had as in actions originally commenced in the District Court.

# SECTION EIGHT

All damages appraised by said Commissioners or determined and awarded by the court together with the expenses and per dism of the commissioners, surveyor and employees shall be paid by the County of Ramsey.

## SECTION HIME

This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
