APPOINTMENT OF COMMITTEE

Isaac Bowman was heard in connection with the opening of a road in the center of Sections 17 and 8, Town 29, R. 23 from Larpenteur Avenue. If one mile of this road was opened the same would provide access to the property on both sides of the road whereas at present people living in this vicinity have no way of getting in or out their property.

Commissioner Farrell made a motion seconded Churchill that the Committee on Roads and Bridges view this road and property adjoining and submit their report to this Board, and that Thursday, June 8th, at 10 o'clock A.M., be designated as the date that said Committee shall meet for that purpose and same carried by the following vote: Ayes: Carr, Churchill, Farrell, Freeman, and Lind. Nays, None.

REQUEST FOR ROAD

Isaac Bowman again requested that the road through the center of Sections 17 and 8, Town 29, Range 23 be improved so that the residents along said road would be able to get in and out of said property.

The records show that the Town of Rose established a road through this section on November 7, 1876⁴⁴² but was again vacated on April 9, 1878.

Mr. Bowman was told that in order to secure a road through this section, it would be necessary to present the usual petition for the establishment of County Roads.
