IT IS WRTHER ORDERED. That the County Auditor notify the Town Supervisors of each town through which said road is vacated of the fact of said vacation and that they shall cause to be vacated so such of said highway as lies in their respective towns.

AND WHEREAS. At the said hearing, upon said petition and said report of said Committee, certain persons over whose lands said vacation of said road will pass did remonstrate against granting the prayer of said petition and did set forth in writing that they would be damaged in a sum therein mentioned by the vacation of such road, and made oath and subscribed to the same, and said Board has determined from said report and the evidence before them, the amounts of the damages sustained by said persons and that said proposed vacation of said road is of sufficient advantage to said County to warrant the paying of the damages assessed by this Board, the said Board proceeded to assess said damages at what is deemed just and right to each land owner, taking into account the advantages and benefits of said vacation of said highway as well as the disadvantages and damages.
