

PETITION FOR VACATION OF COUNTY ROAD

May 17, 1909

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Ramsey, Minnesota:

The undersigned freeholders of the County of Ramsey, Minnesota, residing herein petition your Honorable Board for the vacation of a highway, running into one town of said County, and not within the limits of any incorporated City, and described as follows:

Beginning at the south line of Frost Avenue, on the North side of the South East quarter of Section 15, Township 29, Range 22.

And running thence in a southerly direction through the west half of said south-east quarter, to the North line of Alpine Avenue, thirty (30) feet North of the South line of said Section 15, the said highway as to be vacated being known as Maywood Avenue.

And terminating at Alpine Avenue in New Canada Township.

And your petitioners pray that you will vacate all that portion of said above described highway which runs as follows:

Beginning as above described.

And running thence as above described.

And terminating as above described.

And now connected with other roads as follows: At the North end with Frost Avenue, and at the South end with Alpine Avenue.

The names of the owners of the lands as far as known, through which the same now passes, are: William H. Egan.

And the names of the owners of the lands, as far as known which the same may pass when changed, are - - -

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to vacate said road and cause the same to be vacated according to law. Dated at St. Paul this 14th day of May, 1909.

Nash, Louis Nash, and Peter members of said Board a committee to examine said proposed vacation of said road, and that said committee will meet on said route of said road at County Poor Farm in said county on Friday the 18th day of June, 1909, at 12 o'clock M for the purpose of examination of said proposed vacation of said road, and will report its findings and recommendations to said Board at the time of hearing upon said petition as hereinbefore specified.
