Laying out a Road

The order of the Committee on Roads and Bridges laying out the road, Commencing at a point on the county road known as the St. Paul and Bald Eagle Lake road, where it crosses the track of the Lake Superior and Mississippi Railroad near Goose Lake in Section 22 in the town of White Bear, thence Southwest through Sections 22, 27, 28, 29 and 32 in said town of White Bear, thence South to the line between Sections 6 and 7, thence West on said section line to the corner of Sections 1, 6, 7, and 12 on the town line between the towns of Rose and New Canada - was confirmed and adopted. The Committee also reported the amount of benefits and damages assessed upon the property by reason of the laying out of said road. The report was on motion adopted and confirmed.

A search of the records at times of issuing road orders does not reveal that service of all parties interested was made according to laws of hearing and affidavit of posting made. The Road order by Committee dated and adopted Jan 18, 1875, no record of filing for record in the County Auditor of Ramsey County.

Committee's road order dated Jan 18, 1875, was from a point on the County Road known as Paul Bull Eagle Lake Road where it crosses the of the Lake Superior and Mississippi River near Goose Lake in section 22 in the town of White Bear thence South-West through sections 25-29 and 32 in White Bear Twp thence West to the sec corner of Sec's 1-6-7 and town line between the towns of Rose and Canada. We therefore establish the new County Road # 80 or Goose Lake Road from the Lake Road in the S.E. quarter of Sec 22 T-30-R-30 at a point with the Submer Rd in Sec 25-T-30-R-30 thence terminating.



## Petition for County Road

The petition from Citizens of White Bear and Mounds View Township asking that a new road be laid out and opened through White Bear and Mounds View townships to Rose town and thence to county line according to the route indicated in the petition. Referred to the Committee on Roads and Bridges.
