At a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of said County, held April 7th, 1890, a copy of the report of the countities appeinted by us at our last session, to examine the road hereinafter named, having been duly returned, by which said report it appears that the said countities not at the time and place designated in our order of appointment and examined the highway proposed to be, vis:

Beginning at the south quarter post of section twenty (20), Township thirty (30), Range twenty-three (23), fourth principal meridian, Remosp County, Minnesota; thence running west on the south line of said section twenty (20), to the southwest corner of the southeast quarter (3.2.2) of the southwest quarter (S.W.2) of section twenty (20), themce morth along the west line of said quarter quarter (22) section to the morthwest corner thereof: themce west on the north line of the south half of the southwest quarter (5. W. 2) of said section twenty (20) one-hundred and minety-three 5-10 (193 5-10) feet to the intersection of center line of the eld road; and to vacate the part of the old county road as now laid out and in the south half of the southwest quarter (S.V.2) of section twenty (20), and recommended that the prayer of the petitioners for the change of said high-way be granted: and a majority of the Board of County Commissioners being of the epinion that the public interest would be promoted by the change of said highway, and that the change of said road would be of saf-ficient advantage to the county to warrant the paying of the damages hereimafter assessed, we do hereby order and determine that the prayer of said petitioners be granted, and that the highway be and is hereby changed seconding to the description above given, which is hereby declared to be a public highway, and the Auditor is hereby directed to notify the Supervisors of the several towns through which such highway is changed that they cause so much of said highway as lies in their respective towns to be opened without delay.

We have assessed the damages sustained by reason of the change of said road to the lands over which the same passes and be the owners thereof as follows:
