

PETITION FOR CHANGE OF COUNTY ROAD

June 18, 1906

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Ramsey, Minnesota

The undersigned freeholders of the County of Ramsey, residing therein petition your Honorable Board for the change of a highway, running into more than one town of said County, and not within the limits of any incorporated city, and described as follows:

Beginning at the quarter post on the South line of Section 13, Town Thirty (30), Range Twenty-three (23) and running thence North 18° West 30.92 chains to North line of Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of said Section 13, thence West on said North line to the West line of Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter, thence North to the East and West quarter line of said Section 13, thence West on the quarter line and terminating at the quarter post on the West line of Section 14, Town Thirty (30), Range Twenty-three and your petitioners pray that you will change all that portion of said above described highway which runs as follows:

Beginning at the quarter post between Section 13 and Section 14, Town Thirty (30) Range Twenty-three (23) and running thence West on the quarter line and terminating at the quarter post on the West line of said Section 14, and now connected with other roads as follows: The Mamoria Road at the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 13, and Lexington Ave. at the quarter post on the West line of said Section 14. So that the same when changed will run as follows:

Beginning at the quarter post between Section 13 and 24 Town Thirty (30) Range Twenty-three (23) and running thence West on Section line between Sections 13 and 24 and Sections 14 and 23 and terminating at the Southwest corner of Section 14, Town Thirty (30), Range Twenty-three (23) and to be connected with other roads as follows:

Lake Johanna and White Bear Road at the quarter post between said Sections 13 and 24, and Lexington Ave. at the Southwest corner of Section 14.
