Whereas, upon application in writing of John G. Hapgood, L. M. Ford, E. M. Tozer, J. A. Tozer, J. Kelly, William Orcutt, John Bush, six legal voters residing within one mile of the road hereinafter described for a discontinuance of a public highway a copy of their petition having been first duly posted up as required by law, we, the Supervisors, of said town having personally examined the portions of road proposed to be discontinued in said petition, first portion, commencing at the residence of D.H.J. Baker and terminating near the residence of Stephen Denoyer. Second portion to commence near the residence of Stephen Denoyer and terminating at the Hennepin County line and having before determined to discontinue said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against discontinuing the same and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three of the most public places in said town eight days previous to the time of such meeting and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as was offered for or against the discontinuance of said road, and being of opinion that such discontinuance is necessary and proper and that the public interest would be promoted thereby and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, it is therefore ordered and determined that those portions of road be and the same is hereby discontinued.
