The attention of the County Surveyor, Mr. Paul N. Coates, is respectfully called to the following Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Ramsey County, Minnesota, adopted at the meeting held on the 29th inst. By Commissioner Groos:

RESOLVED: That County Road "G" from South Birch Lake Boulevard east to the west limits of the City of White Bear Lake be, and the same is hereby, constituted and declared a county road, said road being located in Ramsey County and outside the corporate limits of any incorporated city or village therein, pursuant to authority granted under Section 2582, Mason's Statutes of Minnesota for 1927.

BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' ROAD ORDER.

ROAD AT WHITE BEAR VILLAGE

At a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners held Dec. 7, 1886, a copy of the report of the committee appointed by us at our last session to examine the road hereinafter named, having been duly returned by which said report it appears that this said committee met at the time and place designated in our Order of Appointment and examined the highway proposed to be extended. Viz: Beginning at the crossing of the Columbus road when it crosses the Section line between sections 16 and 21 in White Bear Town, extending East to the line of the village of White Bear Lake on the Section line between Sections 16 and 21, 15 and 22, and some time was (more or less) on Sections 14 and 23 to said Village; and recommend that the prayer of the petitioners for the extension of said highway be granted, and a majority of the Board of County Commissioners being of the opinion that the public interest would be promoted by the extension of said highway and that the extension of said road would be of sufficient advantage to the County to warrant the paying of damages hereinafter assessed.

We do hereby order and determine that the prayers of said Petitioners be granted and that a highway be and is hereby laid out according to the description already given which is hereby declared to be a public Highway and the Auditor is hereby directed to notify the Supervisors of several Towns thru which such highway is laid out; that they cause so much of said Highway as lies in their respective towns to be opened without delay.

We have assessed the damages sustained by reason of the laying out and extension of said road to the lands over which the same passes and the supposed damage thereof as follows:
