

SUPERVISORS' ORDER FOR VACATION OF A ROAD

Oct. 29, 1888

Whereas, upon the petition of six legal voters owning real estate or occupying real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States or under contract from the State of Minnesota within one mile of the road proposed in said petition to be vacated, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said town at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit which said proposed vacation is set forth and described in said petition as follows: That part of the town road running through N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 13, T. 29, R. 23, now platted and known as Thornton Subdivision of said N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 13, T. 29, R. 23, in said town be vacated and discontinued from the point where said road intersects the West line of said Thorntons Subdivision of said N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13 to where the same intersects the North line of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 13 and whereas upon receiving said petition we did, within thirty days thereafter make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application to-wit: on the 29th day of October A.D. 1888 at C. F. McCarron's place at one o'clock P.M. causing copies of such notice to be posted up in three public place in said town at least ten days previous to such meeting and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice and being satisfied that the applicant had at least ten days previous to said time caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway passes by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants proof of which was shown by affidavit we proceeded to examine personally such highway and hear any and all reasons for or against discontinuing the same and being of the opinion that such discontinuing was necessary and proper and that the public interest would be promoted thereby we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to discontinue said road the description of which as so discontinued is as follows, to-wit: That part of the town road running through the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 13, T. 29, R. 23, now platted and known as Thorntons Subdivision of said N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 13, T. 29, R. 23 in said town be vacated and discontinued from the point where said road intersects the West line of said Thorntons Subdivision of said N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13 to where the same intersects the North line of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 13.

It is therefore ordered and determined that a road be and the same is hereby discontinued.
