

PETITION FOR CHANGE OF COUNTY ROAD

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Ramsey, Minnesota:

The undersigned freeholders of the County of Ramsey residing therein petition your Honorable Board for the change of a highway, running into more than one town of said County, and not within the limits of any incorporated City, and known as Snelling Avenue Road.

And your petitioners pray that you will vacate all that portion of said above named highway which runs as follows:

Beginning at a point 990 feet more or less, north of the 1/4 Section corner between Sections 9 and 10, Town 29, Range 23; And running thence northeasterly through the north 1/2 of the southwest 1/4 of the northwest 1/4 of Section 10 to a point on the south line of the northwest 1/4 of the northwest 1/4 of said Section 10, so that the same when changed will run north on the Section line between Sections 9 and 10, Town 29, Range 23 from the point of beginning of the above described vacation to the southwest corner of the northwest 1/4 of the northwest 1/4 of Section 10; thence east on the south line of the aforesaid northwest 1/4 of northwest 1/4 to the intersection of the present traveled road.
