

SUPERVISORS' ROAD ORDER

WHEREAS, upon the petition of five legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within two (2) miles of the Cartway proposed in said petition to be laid out; which said petition was filed with the town clerk and copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said Town, at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit; which said proposed Cartway is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz: Beginning at a point on the West line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 11, T. 29, R. 23, forty rods North of the quarter Sec. line East and West of said Sec. 11, T. 29, R. 23; thence running East 160 rods to a point on the East line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12, T. 29, R. 23, forty rods North of the quarter Sec. line East and West of the said Sec. 12, T. 29, R. 23.

AND WHEREAS upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: On the 12th day of May A.D. 1894 at the L. Lepake at one o'clock in the afternoon causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days previous to such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such Cartway might pass by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally, such highway, and heard any and all reasons for or against the laying out of said Cartway, and being of the opinion that such Cartway was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said Cartway accompanying, the description of which as so laid out is as follows, to-wit: Beginning-----as asked for in the above petition.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DETERMINED, That a Cartway be, and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid, and the report and plat herewith accompanying, which is hereby made a part of this Order, and it is hereby declared to be a public Cartway two rods wide, the said description above given being the center of said Cartway.
