

CO. COMM. ROAD ORDER

At a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Ramsey held on the second day of September 1884, the report of the committee appointed by said board at a previous session to examine the highway hereinafter mentioned having been duly returned, from which it appears that said Committee met at the time and place designated in their order of appointment and examined that part of the highway proposed to be vacated described in the petition signed by Charles Mehake, James J. Hill, Robert P. Lewis, A. K. Norman and others presented to and filed with said Board on July 1, 1884 in which report the said Committee recommend that the portion of said road hereinafter mentioned and described be vacated. And this Board having determined from the face of said report and the evidence before them that such portion of said road ought to be vacated,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DETERMINED, That that portion of the road or highway commonly known as the White Bear, Minneapolis and Mounds View Road, commencing on the West line of Section eighteen (18) in Township thirty (30) of Range twenty-two (22) in said Ramsey County, and running thence in an Easterly and Northeasterly direction through said Section eighteen (18) and through Section seventeen (17) Township and Range aforesaid to the West line of the East half of the Northeast quarter of said Section seventeen (17) and also that other portion of said road commencing at a point on the South line of Section thirteen (13) in Township thirty (30) of Range twenty-three (23) in said Ramsey County where said road commences to diverge from said South line and from thence running in a Northeasterly direction to a point where said road intersects the Easterly line of said Section thirteen (13) be, and the said two portions of said highway as above described are hereby declared and are vacated.

The County Auditor of said Ramsey County is hereby directed to notify the Supervisors of the several towns through which said Highway runs of such vacation.

PETITION FOR VACATING

TO THE HONORABLE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RAMSEY COUNTY,  
MINNESOTA

Your Petitioners, freeholders of said Ramsey County respectfully petition that the road commonly known as the White Bear, Minneapolis and Mounds View Road, commencing at the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section thirteen (13) Town thirty (30) Range twenty-three (23) of said Ramsey County, thence running in an Easterly and Northeasterly direction through the East half of said Section thirteen (13) and through Section eighteen (18) Town thirty (30) Range twenty-two (22) and through Section seventeen (17) Town and Range last aforesaid to the West line of the East half of the Northeast quarter of said Section seventeen (17). Also that portion of the same Road commencing on the South line of Section thirteen (13) Town thirty (30) Range twenty-three (23) and running Northeasterly to the East line of said Section thirteen (13), thence Northerly on the Section line to an intersection with the first named portion of said Road be vacated and discontinued.

And, your Petitioners further allege that the said highway runs into more than one Town in said County to-wit: Into the Towns of White Bear and Mounds View; that said Road is not within the limits of any incorporated city; that said Ramsey County contains more than one hundred legal voters; that the names of all the owners of the lands through which said road intended and proposed to be vacated, runs are hereinafter set forth and signed to this Petition.

REPORT OF COMMITTEE

TO THE HONORABLE  
THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RAMSEY COUNTY:

The undersigned committee appointed to examine the highway proposed to be vacated, described and set forth in the petition signed by Charles Mohrke, James J. Hill, Robert P. Lewis, A. K. Barnum, and others presented to and filed with your said Board on July 1st 1884, and described in said petition as follows: that part of the road, commonly known as the White Bear, Minneapolis and Mounds View Road, commencing at the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section thirteen (13) Town thirty (30) Range twenty-three (23) of said Ramsey County, thence running in an Easterly and Northeasterly direction through the East half of said Section thirteen (13) and through Section eighteen (18) Town thirty (30) Range twenty-two (22) and through Section Seventeen (17) town and Range last aforesaid to the West line of the East half of the Northeast quarter of said Section seventeen (17), also that portion of the same road commencing on the South line of Section thirteen (13) Town thirty (30), Range twenty-three (23) and running Northeasterly to the East line of said Section thirteen (13) thence Northerly on the Section line to an intersection with the first named portion of said road, together with the remonstrance of Paul Mayette et al. against said petition, do report as follows:

That your committee gave notice of their meeting and purpose to examine said highway proposed to be vacated, a copy of which notice and proof of the posting thereof in accordance with statute in such case made and provided are hereto assured that your committee met at the time and place stated in said notice and did proceed to and did examine the said highway proposed to be vacated and your committee after such examination recommend that that portion of the said road commencing on the Westerly line of Section eighteen (18) Township thirty (30) Range twenty-three (23) and from thence running in an Easterly and Northeasterly direction through said Section eighteen (18) and through Section seventeen (17) Township and Range aforesaid, and ending at the Easterly line of the East half of the Northwest quarter of said Section seventeen (17) be vacated, and your committee further recommend that that portion of said road secondly above described commencing at a point on the South line of the Southeast quarter of Section thirteen (13) Township thirty (30) Range twenty-three (23) at a point where said road commences to diverge from said South line and from thence running in a Northeasterly direction until it intersects the Easterly line of said Section thirteen (13) be also vacated, and your committee makes the ~~attached~~ plat a part of their report; the blue lines indicating the part that is recommended to be vacated.

They would also report that they have fully considered the protest referred to them, and did on the morning of August 14th last at the school house in District No. 25, meet and hear H. S. Patts, S. Thompson, W. V. Athey, P. H. Dunn, A. Simpson, Thos. Ryan, John Dalquist, Henry Bouker, G. Harpot or as many as desired to speak for or against said petition and after personally inspecting the premises and considering the matter of benefits and damages, your Committee would recommend the adoption of the within order.
