The undersigned William Lindeke, John Wagner and D. H. Hunt, committee appointed to examine the proposed location of a highway running into more than one town of said county and not within the limits of any incorporated city and running into the towns of New Canada and Rose in said Ramsey County as stated in the petition referred to in our order of appointment, respectfully report that the said highway was proposed to be located as follows, to-wit:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RAMSEY COUNTY, that whereas it has been duly made to appear by affidavits duly made and filed before this Board and this Board is satisfied that at least thirty days notice prior to the 5th day of August, 1879 has been duly given of a hearing of a certain petition of N. Pothon, W. B. Quinn, and others for the location of a highway running into more than one town and not within the limits of any incorporated city, and running into the towns of New Canada and Rose in said Ramsey County, and which said proposed highway commences in Columbus Road at a point nine and seven eighths chains North of point on Section line 10.75 chains East of 1/4 Section Corner between Sections Six and Seven, Town Twenty-nine, Range Twenty-two (Town of New Canada) running thence as stated in said petition and terminating on the line between Ramsey and Hennepin Counties and known as the New Canada and Rose Town Road, which said petition was laid before this said Board at its extra session held at the office of the County Auditor of said Ramsey County on the third day of June, 1879, by posting up notices in three of the most public places in each of said towns of New Canada and Rose and that said notices were so duly posted on the 25th day of June, 1879.

Now it is hereby further resolved that a Committee consisting of the following members of said board, to-wit: William Lindeke, John Wagner, and D. H. Hunt be and they are hereby appointed to examine the highway proposed to be located as asked in said petition and to report to said Board at an extra session thereof to be held on the 2nd day of September, 1879 at ten o'clock in the forenoon at the County Auditor's office in said County and the said Board hereby designate the 12th day of August, 1879 at 9 o'clock in the forenoon as the time when and the residence of Erroll Crossley in Rose ~~Town~~ to-wit: the Southwest Corner of Section Eleven in said Rose Town as the place where such Committee will meet upon said road.
