The undersigned, legal voters, residing within three miles of the route hereinafter mentioned and described for a road, do hereby petition to you to lay out a new road, of the width of four rods, as follows: Commencing at the centre of the "Buluth Highway" between Sec. 1, T. 30, R. 22, Ramsey Co. and Sec. 31, T. 31, R. 21, Washington County, thence running East on the line between said Ramsey and Washington Counties to the centre of the White Bear and Hugo road or Portland Ave, se-called, at the N.E. corner of the N.V. of the N.E. of Sec. 1, T. 30, R. 22, and there terminating, and including as part of this proposed road the present Town road - two rods in width - running along the southern boundary line of the E. of the S.W. of Sec. 32, T. 31, R. 21, said proposed road to be four rods wide, two rods on each side of the line between said Ramsey and Washington counties.



WHERMAS, upon the petition in writing of John Slawa, M. O. Lund, John Hamble, Lee Scheeller, Andrew Slawa, Wm. Schletty, Henry Youngblut, Mels Anderson, Erick G. Melson, Jerry Gallivan, Frank Hamble, Ed. Jurjes, Bugene Arcand, Wm. Perren, A. Bloom, F. Arcand, J. H. Haar, Chas. Erickson, F. W. Benson, B. H. Benson, and C. W. Benson, twenty-one legal voters, residing within three miles of the read hereinafter described, (the opening of which is prayed for in said Petition) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said towns, did, on the 23rd day of October, A.D. 1920, personally examine the read proposed in said petition to be laid out, to-wit:
