Also Reservoir Ave. also known as Broadway from the Easterly line of Minnesota Belt Line RR Right of Way to Lexington Ave., being the East and West Road through the Center of Section 15, 16, and 17, Town 29, Range 23, be and the same is hereby constituted and declared a County Road, the same not being within the corporate limits of any city or town. On motion by Commissioner Groos, seconded Carr, same was adopted by the following vote: Ayes: Carr, Groos, Leinen and Lind. Nays, None.

Whereas, Upon the petition of twelve legal voters who own real estate or the occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within two (2) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out; which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk previous to the time of posting copies thereof, and copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said Town, at least twenty days before any action was had in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit; which said proposed new road is set forth and described in said petition as follows, viz:

Beginning at Cleveland Ave. at a point being the Northeast corner of the Southeast 1/4 of Section seventeen (17) Township twenty nine (29) Range twenty three (23) West; thence due West on the 1/2 section line to which it intersects with Oak St., the said road to be four (4) rods wide.

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition, we did, within thirty days thereafter, make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit: On the 10th day of February, A.D. 1900 at the road to be laid out at 2 o'clock P.M. causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said Town, at least ten days previous to such meeting; and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant had, at least ten days previous to said time, caused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass, by serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to examine personally such highway, and heard any and all reasons for or against the laying out of the same, and being of opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, we granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road, accompanying, the description of which as so is as follows, to-wit:

Award of Damages

Whereas, A road was laid out on the 10th day of February A.D. 1900, by us, the Supervisors of the said Town of Rose on the petition of twelve (12) legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within two (2) miles of said road, which said road is set forth and described in the foregoing Supervisors' Order, made by us, and,

Whereas, A part of the damages sustained by reason of the laying out said road has been ascertained by the agreement of the owners of the lands through which said road passes, with us, and a part of the owners of the said lands have in writing released all claims to damages; but not being able to agree with the owners of the following described lands, claiming damages by reason of said highway passing through, and the owners of some of the said lands being unknown, we have assessed the damages to each of such individual claimants with whom we could not agree, and awarded damages to the square of such lands through which such highway passes as are unknown, at what we deemed just and right; taking into account and estimating the advantages and benefits the road will confer on the claimants and owners, as well as the disadvantages. We have assessed and awarded damages as follows:
