Whereas, upon the petition of nineteen (19) legal voters who own real estate or who occupy real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States or under contract from the State of Minnesota within two (2) miles of the road proposed in said petition to be laid out, which said petition was filed with the Town Clerk previous to the time of posting copies thereof and copied of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said town at least twenty days before any action was held in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit which said proposed new road is set forth and described in said petition as follows; viz:

Beginning on Snelling Ave. at the Northwest corner of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section fifteen (15) Township twenty nine (29) Range three (23) and running East 1 mile on 1/2 section line to the Northeast corner of the Northeast 1/4 of Southeast 1/4 of Section fifteen (15) Township twenty nine (29) Range three (23) said description to be the center of said road.

And Whereas, Upon receiving said petition we did within thirty days thereafter make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet to decide upon such application to wit: on 9th day of April, at 9 o'clock in the forenoon at Town Hall causing copies of such notices to be posted in three public places in said Town and each property owner along said proposed road we summoned at least ten days previous to such meeting and having met at said time and place as above named in said notice and being satisfied that the applicants had at least five days previous to such meeting given said notice of time and place of meeting to be given to all the owners of land through which such highway would run and serving the same personally or by copy left at the usual place of residence of said owners, proof of which was shown by affidavit, we proceeded to consider the laying out of such highway, and then hear any and all reasons for or against the laying out of said road and being of the opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper and that the public interest would be promoted, we granted the power of the said petitioners and decided to lay out said road, the description of which is as follows; viz:

Beginning on Snelling Ave. at the Northwest corner of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section fifteen (15) Township twenty nine (29) Range three (23) and running East 1 mile on 1/2 section line to the Northeast corner of the Northeast 1/4 of Southeast 1/4 of Section fifteen (15) Township twenty nine (29) Range twenty three (23). Said description to be the center of the road. It is further ordered and determined that a road be and the same is hereby laid and made a public way four (4) rods wide.
