Resolved, That the road in New Canada Township, commencing at the 1/4 1/4 corner of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section fourteen (14) Township twenty nine (29) Range twenty two (22); thence running in a NE'ly direction to the center of Section fourteen, (14) where it intersects with the road known as East 7th St. of North St. Paul. Said road to be known as East Seventh. The same to be and is hereby accepted and adopted as a County road from this date. Adopted.

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ROAD PETITION

To the Supervisors of the Town of New Canada in the County of Ramsey & State of Minn.
