PETITION FOR COUNTY ROAD

Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of New Canada Township met this 28th day of June, 1873.

The Board ordered the grant for the following described road, Petition, To the Supervisors of the town of New Canada, County of Ramsey and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned legal voters residing within one mile of the road to be laid out, hereby petition you to lay out a new road of the width of four (4) rods as follows:

Commencing at the present traveled New Canada road at the center of section 20, township 29, range 22, thence running in a northerly direction and as near as possible through the center of sections 20-17-6 in said New Canada Township until it strikes the Village of St. John's City or commonly called Little Canada:

The names of the owners of the land over which the road is to pass which are known to your petitioners are the following:

T.W. Leonard, W.H. Webb, George Wilder, Jesse Wilson, Ellen P. Wilder, Robert H. Sayer, Eva W. King, C. Frier, T.M. Finch, Parker Paine, John Mainger, Peter Gano, Casper Achrein, S.A. Lambert, Alex Ducharme, L. Lambert, J.H. and P. and L. Lambert, C. Garvais.

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to lay out said road, and cause the same to be opened according to law. Dated this 13th day of February, 1873.

ROAD ORDER

Ramsay County )  
Town of New Canada ) ss.

Whereas upon the petition in writing of sixteen legal voters residing within one mile of the route hereinafter described for a public highway a copy of their petition having been first duly posted as required by law on the 5th day of April, 1873, personally examined the route proposed in said petition for a new road, and having before determining to lay out said road fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against laying out the same and having caused written notice thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered for or against the laying out said road, and being of opinion that such laying out is necessary and proper and that the public interest would be promoted thereby and having granted the prayer of said petitioners and determined to lay out said road,

We did on the 5th day of April, 1873 cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor who made a report to us as follows:

To the Supervisors of the town of New Canada in the County of Ramsay and State of Minnesota,

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a road, beginning at the present traveled New Canada road at the center of section 20 township 29, range 22, thence running in a northerly direction and as near as possible, through the center of sections 20, 17, and 8 in said New Canada Township until it strikes a village of St. John's City or commonly called Little Canada, would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your direction to-wit:

Commencing at the center of section twenty (20) aforesaid and the present traveled New Canada Road, thence north on quarter section line 20.83 chains to the quarter post between sections 17 & 20, thence north 19.90 chains to quarter of quarter post, thence north 49° east, 7.60 chains to a post, thence north 18° west 2.00 chains, thence north 40° west, 3.00 chains to a post on section line of section, thence north 6.60 chains to center of section 17, thence north 29.84 chains to quarter post between sections 8 and 17, thence north through center of section 8, 20.10 chains to quarter post between sections 8 & 8, thence west on section line 14.50 chains to old road, and that herewith is a correct plat of said road, according to said survey.
