At a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of said County held Feb. 6, 1889, a copy of the report of the committee appointed by us, to examine the road hereinafter named, having been duly returned, by which said report it appears that the said committee met at the time and place designated in our order of appointment and examined the highway proposed to be continued as follows: Beginning from Mounds View Township southerly on the quarter section line in Section 4, Town 29, Range 23, commencing (four rods wide) at the aforesaid County Road about ten rods North of the quarter section post of section 4 and 9, thence running South on quarter section line to quarter section post of section 9 and 16 and to intersect with the County Road running East to Snelling Ave.

And recommended that the prayer of the petitioners for the continuation of said highway be granted; and a majority of the Board of County Commissioners being of the opinion that the public interest would be promoted by the continuation of said highway and that the continuation of said road would be of sufficient advantage to the County, we do hereby order and determine that the prayer of said petitioners be granted, and that a highway be and is hereby opened according to the description above given, which is hereby declared to be a public highway, and the Auditor is hereby directed to notify the Supervisors of the several towns through which said highway is opened, that they cause so much of said highway as lies in their respective towns to be opened without delay.

We have assessed the damages sustained by reason of the opening and continuation of said road to the lands over which the same passes to be equal to the benefits thereof.
