Ounty held Feb. 6, 1889, a copy of the report of the committee appointed by us, to examine the road hereinafter named, hereing been duly returned, by which said report it appears that the said committee met at the time and place designated in our committee met at the time and place designated in our committee of appointment and examined the highway proposed to be continued vis: Beginning from Mounds View Township southerly on the quarter section line in Section 4, Town 29, Range 23, committee (four rods wide) at the aforesaid County Road about ten rods Weekle of the quarter section post of section 4 and 9, thence running section 9 and 16 and to intersect with the County Road running Fact to Snelling Ave.

And recommended that the prayer of the petitioners for the continuation of said highway be granted; and a majority of the Board of County Commissioners being of the opinion of that the making interest would be promoted by the continuation of said highway and that the continuation of said road would be of sufficient advantages to the County, we do hereby order and determine that the prayer as said petitioners be granted, and that a highway be and is hereby opened according to the description above given, which is hereby described to be a public highway, and the Auditor is hereby directed to notify the Supervisors of the several towns through which to highway is opened, that they seems so much of said highway are likely in their respective towns to be opened without delay.

We have assessed the damages sustained by reason of the opening and continuation of said road to the lands over which the same passes to be equal to the benefits thereof.

Whereas, on the 5th day of January, 1885, a petition, signed by 24 or more free-holders of said county, was presented to us, parying for the continuation of a highway, running into more than one town of said county and not within the limits of any incorporated city, and described as follows:

For the continuation of county read running from Mounds View southerly on the quarter section line in section 4, township 29, range 23, commencing 4 rods on the aforesaid county reads, about 10 rods north of quarter section post of sections 4 and 9, thense running due south on quarter section line to quarter section post sections 9 and 16, to intersection of the County read running east to Snelling Avenue and being satisfied that at least 30 days notice thereof has been given before this seesten of the Board by posting up notices in 3 of the most public places in each of the towns thru which such highway is proposed to be continued.
