#### Proposed New Road

Thereas upon the speciation six legal voters owning real estate or compying real estate under the homestead or pre-emption laws of the United States or under contract from the State of Minnesota within one mile of the read proposed in said petition to be laid out copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in three of the most public places of said town at least 20 days before any action was had in relation there to proof of which posting was duly shown to us by affidavit which said proposed new read is set forth and described in said petition as follows, vis:

Deginning at southwest corner of section 17, township 29, range 25 west, running thence east on the section line 60 rods more or less until it interesects from Avenue and whereas upon receiving said petition we did within 30 days thereafter make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application, to-wits

On the 6th day of May, 1886, at the house of Mrs. Mary Bohan, eausing copies of such notice to be posted up in three public places in said team at least 10 days previous to such meeting and having met at such time and place as above named in said notice and being satisfied that the applicant had at least 10 days previous to said time ecused said notice of time and place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which such highway might pass by serving the same personally or by copy left at the nexal place of abode of each of said occupants proof of which was shown by affidavit we proceeded to examine personally such highway and hear any and all reasons for or against laying out the same and being of the opinion that such laying out was necessary and proper and that the public interest would be presented thereby we granted the preyer of said petition and determined to lay out said read the description of which as so laid out is as follows:

Beginning at the SW. corner of section 17, township 29, mange 23 weet, running thence east on the section line 60 rods more or less until it intersects Comp Avenue. It is therefore ordered and determined that a road be and the same is hereby laid out and established according to the description last aforesaid and it is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide the said description above given being the center of said road. Dated May 6th, 1886.

### CLAIMING DAMAGES

Thereas a road was laid out on the May 6th, 1886, by the undersigned supervisors of the Thum of Rose on the petition of six legal voters evening real estate or occupying real estate under the homestead or pre-suption laws of the United States or under contrast from the State of Minnesota within every a mile of said road which said road is set forth and described in the supervisors exist as follows, vis:

Beginning at the SW, corner of section 17, township 29, range 23 west, warning thence cost on the section line 60 rods more or less until it intersects Come Avenue and we have assessed and awarded damages and benefits to the owners of such land through which such highway passes at what we deemed just and right taking into account the estimating the diventages and benefits the read will confer on the claimants and owner as well as the disadvantages.
