Order for relocating County Road known as Bald Ragle and St. Paul Road;

Whereas, Upon the p tities in writing of thirty-two legal voters, freeholders residing within the limits of New Consda and White Bear for a county road, a copy of their petition having been first duly pested in three public places on the line of said road as required by law, Committee on Roads and Bridges, Commissioners of Ramsey County did on the 16th day of July, A.D. 1875, personally examine and adopt the line of eaid road as new laid out with all variations from former plat and survey to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the South shere of Bald Regie Lake between SEt and SW2 of Section 11, Township 30, Range 22, thence South on 1/4 list between Section 11 and 14, thence South on center line of Section line 1 to the 1/4 post near White Bear lake, thence SW to road on section lin West of railroad track, thence South to town line near corner of Sect 34 and 33 in White Bear foun and 3 and 4 in the Town of New County, South on the section line between Sections 3 and 4 in the Town of New Gos thence through Sections 9, and 16 to Phalen Creek, thence Skly and Skily as direct a line as possible to a point in the St. Perl and New Comeda H the center of Section 20, thense along said New Canada Road to M St.Paul, and upon determining to report the changes made in said read, in the grading and making of the same, and being of the opinion that the public interests would be promoted thereby and having determined to adopt said variations and change made in said road as had been made from the original survey. We did on the 15th day of August 1875 cause a resurvey there be made by a competent surveyor who made a report to us as follows:-

The above road order dated September 4, 1875, extended from a point beginning at a post on the south shore of Baid Magle Lake between 8E, quarter and SV, quarter of section 11, township 30, range 22, southerly through sections 14, 23, 27, 34 to section corner between 4 and 3, township 29, range 22, southending 5\*1y, and SW1y, through sections 4, 9 and 16 to quarter section line and Little Constant road, thence to the center of section 20, township 29, range 22, Town of New Canada.

We therefore establish the present county road \$15-B or Bald Barte are beginning at a point on the south shore of Bald Eagle Lake between the SE, and SW, I at Bald Eagle Lake Blvd, in section 11, township 30, range 22, themes running south on the north and south half section line of section 11 and 14, and terminating at a point between the SE, quarter and SW, quarter of section 14, township 30, range 22, at S.T.H. \$61 in the town of White Bear.
