DESIGNATING COUNTY ROAD

May 2, 1932

RESOLVED That BUFFALO AVENUE as traveled at the present time from Eagle Avenue to State Trunk Highway No. 1, the center line of which is described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is 1356.08 feet north, and 30.00 feet west of the W.1/4 corner of Sec. 12, Twp. 30 N., Rge. 22 W., said point being on the centerline of Eagle Avenue; thence south 88°26' east a distance of 648.47 feet; thence north 88°30' east a distance of 678.79 feet to the center line of State Trunk Highway No. 1,

be, and the same is hereby, constituted and declared to be a public highway and designated as a COUNTY ROAD, said road being located in Section 12, Township 30, Range 22, in Ramsey County and outside of the corporate limits of any incorporated city or village therein.

Adopted by the following vote: Ayes - Carr, Gibbs, Stewart, Swan, and Peter. Nays - None.

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County Surveyor Coates then reported that the request of the Town Board of NEW CANADA has been considered, and it is recommended that BOCK STREET from County Road "A-2" to County Road "D", a distance of two and one-half miles be added to the County Road system beginning January 1, 1933. This road has been graded and graveled during the past two years to meet the standards for secondary county roads. He also recommended that their request for taking over and maintaining CORTLAND STREET from County Road "A" to County Road "A-2" be denied as this street does not meet any standards of county road construction and should therefore not be considered until it has been graded to meet the standard requirements of a secondary county road.

After consideration of said report, Commissioner Swan moved, seconded by Commissioner Gibbs, that the recommendations be received, concurred in, and approved, and motion carried by the following vote: Ayes - Carr, Gibbs, Peter, Swan, and Mahoney. Nays - None.

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Commissioner Swan introduced the following resolution and moved the adoption thereof:

RESOLVED THAT BOCK STREET from County Road "A-2" to County Road "D", in New Canada Township, be, and the same is hereby, constituted and declared a COUNTY ROAD, pursuant to authority granted under Section 2582, Mason's Statutes of Minnesota for 1927.

Adopted by the following vote: Ayes - Carr, Churchill, Gibbs, Peter Stewart, Swan, and Mahoney. Nays - None.
