ORDER LAYING OUT A NEW ROAD

Whereas, upon the petition in writing, of Felix Labarre, Felix Petuzum, Mitchell Tardiff, Andras Auges, Joseph Auges, E. O. Rene, and Paul LaBarre, seven legal voters, residing within one mile of the road hereinafter described, (of which is prayed for in said petition) a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said town, did on the 6th day of July, A. D., 1872, personally examine the route proposed in said petition for a road to-wit: Commencing at the town road that runs East and West on Section line between Sections 25 and 36, thence North on quarter section line of Sections 25 and 24 to White Bear Lake on said quarter line and having, before determining to lay out said road, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the laying out of the same, and having caused written notices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said road ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were offered, and being of the opinion that such laying out of said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out the said road, we did, on the 5th day of August, A. D., 1872, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit: To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Ramsey and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a Road beginning at the quarter section corner post on the South boundary of Section twenty-five (25), thence North along the quarter section of said section 25 to section twenty-four (24), thence north along the quarter section line of said section twenty-four (24) to the South shore of White Bear Lake, and would report that the following is a correct survey thereof as made by me under your direction, to-wit:

And that below is a correct plat of said road, according to said survey.

Dated at St. Paul this 10th day of August, 1872
Township 30 Range 22 of Principal Meridian

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that said road be and is hereby laid out and established according to said survey, and the plat hereunto annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods wide, the line of said survey being the center of said Road.

PETITION FOR NEW ROAD

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Ramsey and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned, legal voters, residing within one mile of the route hereinafter mentioned and described for a road, do hereby petition to you to lay out a new road of the width of four rods, as follows:

Commencing at the Town road that runs East and West on Section line of Section 25 and 36, thence North on quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) Section line of Sections 25 and 24 on the most eligible route to White Bear Lake on said quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) section line.

The names of the owners of lands over which the same is to pass, which are known to your petitioners, are the following: August Preba, Joseph Auger, Mitchell Tardiff, Felix Labarre, and others unknown to your petitioners.

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to lay out said road, and cause the same to be opened according to law.

ASSESSMENT OF DAMAGES

Assessment of Damages of Opening road in town of White Bear, County of Ramsey, from town road, that runs East and West to White Bear Lake.

We, the undersigned Supervisors of the town of White Bear in the County of Ramsey having on the 13th day of September, A.D., 1872, upon due application made to us for that purpose, laid out a road as follows: Commencing at the town road that runs East and West, on section line of sections 25 and 36, thence North on quarter section line of sections 25 and 24 to White Bear Lake, on said quarter section line.

To August Reada we estimate the damages to his land at twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars, to Jos. Auger, Felix Labarre, Mitchell Hardiff and others unknown, we estimate that the advantages and benefits, said road will confer, on the land owned by the above named parties along the line of said road, are equal to all damages sustained by them, by reason of laying out of said road.
