



Town Line Road Order between the towns of White Bear and New Canada, State of  
Minnesota, County of Ramsey, town of White Bear. 28

Road Order

Whereas upon the petition of more than twelve legal voters, owning or  
occupying real estate within one mile of the road proposed in said petition  
to be laid out, copies of said petition having been first duly posted up in  
three of the most public places of said towns at least twenty days before any  
action was had in relation thereto, proof of which posting was duly shown to  
us by affidavit, which said proposed new road is set forth and described in  
said petition as follows, viz:

Beginning at a point on the County line between the Counties of Ramsey  
and Washington, where the Township line of the Townships of White Bear and  
New Canada intersects said County line. Thence West along the said Township  
line of White Bear and New Canada or as near said line as practicable to  
where the County road known as the St. Paul and Centerville Road in southern  
thirty three (33) and four (4) crosses said Township line.

And whereas, upon receiving said petition we did within thirty days  
thereafter make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we  
would meet and decide upon such application, to-wit:

On the 13th day of April A.D. 1883, at the house of August Reilly,  
causing copies of such notice to be posted in three public places in said  
town, at least ten days previous to such meeting; and having met at such time  
and place as above named in said notice, and being satisfied that the applicant  
had at least ten days previous to said time, caused such notice of time and  
place of hearing to be given to all the occupants of the land through which  
such highway might pass, by serving the same personally or by copy left at the  
usual place of abode of each of said occupants, proof of which was shown by  
affidavit we proceeded to examine personally such highway and heard any and  
all reasons for or against laying out of the same, and being of the opinion  
that such laying out was necessary and proper and that the public interests  
would be promoted thereby we granted the prayer of the petitioners, and  
determined to lay out said road, and caused thereof a survey to be made  
according to the report and plat accompanying the description of which as so  
laid out is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning on the Town line between Townships twenty nine (29) and thirty  
(30) North Range twenty two (22) West at the Northeast corner of Section two  
(1) Township twenty nine (29) North Range twenty two (22) West; the road being  
also the Southeast corner of Section thirty six (36) Township thirty (30) North  
Range twenty two (22) West and running thence West along said town line, (being  
the line between the Towns of New Canada and White Bear) to the intersection  
with the center of the Centerville Road at a point on said town line 10.00 chains  
West from the 1/4 Section Corner between Section four (4) Township twenty nine  
(29) North Range twenty two (22) West and Section thirty three (33) Township  
thirty (30) North Range twenty two (22) West. It is therefore ordered and deter-  
mined that a road be and the same is hereby laid out and established according  
to the description last aforesaid and the report and plat accompanying which  
is hereby made a part of this order, and it is hereby declared to be a public  
highway four (4) rods wide the said description above given being the center of  
said road.

NEW CANADA AND WHITE BEAR TOWNSHIPS

Road Petition

To the Supervisors of the Town of New Canada in the County of Ramsey and State of Minn.

The undersigned, legal voters who own real estate, or who occupy real estate under the Homestead or Pre-emption Laws of the United States, or under contract from the State of Minnesota, within one (1) mile of the road to be laid out, twenty eight (28) hereby petition you to lay out as follows:

Beginning at a point on the County line between the Counties of Ramsey and Washington where Township line of Township White Bear and New Canada intersects said County line; thence West along said County line, Township line of White Bear and New Canada or as near said Township line as practicable to where the County road known as the St. Paul and Centerville Road in Section thirty three (33) and thirty four (34) crosses said Township line.

The Board of Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Ramsey and the State of Minnesota met at the Hall House in said town and the following business in regard to roads was done. Present H.O. Rens, Joseph Reif and Valentine Rapp.

They issued an order declaring the following described route a public highway between the towns of White Bear and New Canada.

Commencing on the town line between townships twenty nine (29) and thirty (30) North Range twenty two (22) West the same being also the Southeast corner of Section thirty six (36) Township thirty (30) Range twenty-two (22) and running thence West along said town line being the line between the towns of White Bear and New Canada to the intersection with the center of the Centerville Road at a point on said town line 10.26 chains west from the quarter section corner between Section four (4) Township twenty nine (29) Range twenty two (22) West and Section thirty three (33) Township thirty North of Range twenty two (22) West. They also assessed benefits and damages to the owners of lands through which said road passed as follows:

To J. Hanback the owner of the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section thirty six (36) damages \$30.05 benefits \$30.00, to Wm. Hall the owner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section thirty six (36) damages \$40.05 benefits \$40.05, to Paul Tabbarre the owner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section thirty five (35) damages at \$15.05 benefits \$15.00, to Wm. Gale the owner of W $\frac{1}{2}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section thirty five (35) damages at \$20.00, to Theodore Hamm the owner of S $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section thirty five (35) damages at \$40.00, to John Bolthen the owner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section thirty-four (34) damages at \$20.00 benefits at \$20.00, to Wm. Van Der Weide the owner of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section thirty four (34) damages at \$20.05 benefits \$20.00, to Simon Labarre the owner of S $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section thirty four damages \$15.00, to C.C. Nashburn the owner of S $\frac{1}{2}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section thirty three damages of \$30.05 benefits \$30.00, to Narcisse Belland the owner of S $\frac{1}{2}$  of S $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section thirty three (33) we do assess his damages at \$15.00 by reason of laying out of said road all of said lands being in Township thirty (30) Range twenty two (22).
