ROAD ORDER

RAMSEY COUNTY )
TOWN OF WHITE BEAR)

Order - laying out a new road.

Mereas, upon the petition in writing, of twelve (12) freeholders residing in said town, a copy of their petition having been first duly posted, as required by law, we, the Supervisors of said town, did on the 6th day of July, A.D. 1872, personally examine the route of the new road proposed in said petition, to-wit:

Commencing at Birch Lake at a point where the quarter line of Section 15 crosses said lake on the South shore thereof, thence South en said line, or as near said quarter line as practicable to the county read west of Goese Lake, and west of L. S. & M. R. R. and having, before determining to lay out said read, fixed upon a time and place when and where we would meet to hear any reasons for or against the laying out of the same, and having caused writtenmastices thereof to be posted up in three public places near the line of said read ten days previous to the time of such meeting, and having met at the time and place appointed for hearing such reasons, and having heard such as were effered, and being of the spinion that such laying out of the said road is necessary and proper, and that the public interest would be promoted thereby, and having granted the prayer of said petitioners, and determined to lay out the said read, we did, on the second day of August A.D. 1872, cause a survey thereof to be made by a competent surveyor, who made report to us, as follows, to-wit:

To the Supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Ransey, and State of Kinnesota:

The undersigned having been employed by you to make a survey of a road beginning at the Southeast shore of Birch Lake at a point where the quarter line of Section fifteen (15) intersects said shore; thence South on said quarter line, or as near said line as practicable, to the county road West of Goese Lake and West of L.S. & M. R. in Section 22, and I certify that herewith is a correct plat of said survey, and that below is a correct plat of said road, according to said survey. \* Survey notes are typed at bottom of page.

(Dated at St. Faul this 10th day of August, 1873)

Township 30, Range No. 22 of West, Principal Meridian.

It is, therefore, ordered and determined that the said road be and is kereby laid out and established according to said survey, and the plat hereunte annexed and made part of this order, which road is hereby declared to be a public highway four road wide, the line of said survey being the center of said road.

The supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Ramsey, and State of Minnesota.

The undersigned freeholders residing in the Town of White Bear de hereby petition you to lay out a new road, of the width of four rods, as fellows:

Commencing at the South side of Birch Lake, at or near where the quarter section line crosses said lake in lots 5 and 4 in said Town of White Bear and running from thence in a Southerly direction on said quarter line or as near said line as practicable to the county road on the West side of Geose Lake, and West of the L. S. & M. R.R. in Section 22, on the most eligible route to said county road, known as the St. Paul and Bald Eagle Lake Road.

### ASSESSMENT OF DAMAGES.

By opening read in Town of White Bear in County of Ransey, from Direk Lake to County read, west of Goose Lake and west of L.S. & M. R.R.

We, the undersigned supervisors of the Town of White Bear in the County of Ramsey, having on the 13th day of September, A.D. 1872, upon due application made to us, for that purpose, laid out a road as follows:

Gommencing at the South side of Birch Lake at a point where the quarter section line of Section 15 crosses said Lake, on the South shore thereof, thence Southerly on said line, or as near said line as practicable, to the county read west of Goose Lake, and West of L.S. & M. R.R. in Section 22, and to the fellowing named owners of land over which said road passes. J. H. Stewart, D. Demare, Chas. J. Evans, John Kirkham, and others unknown, we estimate that the advantages and benefits, said road will confer on the land owned by the above named parties along the line of said road are equal to all damages sustained by them, by reason of laying out of said road.
